ANTI-DUMPING COMPLAINT AGAINST IMPORTS OF CERTAIN COMPRESSORS ORIGINATING IN CHINA

The European Commission has notified Member States that a complaint has been received from one Community producer of certain compressors. The producers represented by the complaint correspond to a major portion, more than 50% of the EU production of the product. The product is classified to CN codes: ex 8414 40 10; 8414 80 27; ex 8414 80 28 and ex 8414 80 51. It is likely that Member States will give the go-ahead to the initiation of an anti-dumping investigation. The notice of initiation, expected to be published within a week or so, will be available in the Official Journal of the European Union available on line at:- www.europa.eu.int or <http://eur-lex.europa.eu/en/index.htm>

Under the basic Regulations, the European Commission may impose provisional anti-dumping measures no earlier than sixty days after the initiation of an investigation and no later than nine months. In practice, most duties are not imposed until six months or later after the investigation has started.

Please note the deadline in the notices of initiation for making your interest known to the European Commission.
