**ANTI-DUMPING COMPLAINT CONCERNING IMPORTS OF CERTAIN CANDLES ORIGINATING IN
THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA.**

The European Commission notified Member States that a complaint had been received from seven Community producers representing approximately 35% of Community production. After consulting Member States, the Commission decided to launch a formal anti-dumping investigation. The Notice of Initiation was published in the Official Journal of the European Communities on 16 February 2008. The reference is C43/14. Paragraph 6(a) of the Notice of Initiation invites interested parties to request a questionnaire or other claim form no later than 26 February 2008.

Under the basic anti-dumping regulation the Commission may impose provisional anti-dumping measures no earlier than 60 days after the initiation of an investigation and no later than nine months.
